- 1. Print out a copy of the card.
- 2. Turn the card so that the back side (the side with numbers 1 and 2) is on the lower left.
- 3. Fold along line 1, so that the number is still visible.
- 4. Fold along line 2, so that the number is still visible.
- 5. Tape the card to your garbage can or recycling bin as you place it on the curb, making sure the card can be seen easily.

Along with this thank you card, there are many other ways you can help us thank our proud waste & recycling workers!

Call your local waste management office and tell them how much you appreciate them.

- Consider taping the card to a bottle of water to quench their thirst.
- Bake some tasty goodies for them, such as cookies or muffins.
- Buy them a gift card.
