WHEREAS, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the eradication of many diseases in the Western World is due in large part to higher public sanitation standards resulting from effective garbage disposal; and

WHEREAS, the proper collection and disposal of waste and recyclables are vital to preventing disease, litter, and contamination of our air, land, and water; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico values and celebrates our local solid waste industry employees for their commitment to our residents, businesses, and communities in keeping our communities safe and clean.
